₁ Core Enhancement Structured Elective options: ENTP 3001, HURE 3001, REAL 3001. Data Analytics Structured Elective options: ACCO 4060, AIIM 4320 (AIIM Majors), AIIM 4420 (AIIM Majors), BUAN 3065, ECON 4060, FINA 4050, INSY 4052, MARK 4060, OSCM 4060, REAL 4061, REAL 4210 (REAP Majors). If a course is taken to complete the Business Ethics, Core Enhancement and Analytics structured electives, it can fulfill both the business core and a major requirement if eligible. Note that an additional upper division business elective may be required to meet credit requirements if a structured elective is used to fulfill two academic areas.

₂ Students can apply a maximum of two business courses for both Discovery Tier requirements and business core, major, upper division business electives to reduce overall credits a student needs to graduate; a maximum reduction of 6 credits in total.

₃ ACCO 4050 is an ACCO major required course replacing the Business Core requirement INSY 3001 Introduction to Information Systems.

₄ ANY BUSINESS ELECTIVE – 6 HOURS MINIMUM REQUIRED. Students may apply these business electives toward a second major by fulfilling the associated major’s requirements.

NOTES:

- 2.000 cumulative gpa is required in all Marquette University courses and a 2.500 gpa in business courses
- A grade of C or higher must be earned in each major course including the core course(s) introducing the major – ACCO 1030/ACCO 1031
- One international business course is required (within or outside your major)
- Students can dual apply one course across two business majors when possible. This dual application does not change the minimum credit requirement to graduate and may require a student to take additional business elective course(s) to meet credit and course requirements.
- Students can choose to major in more than ACCO. Doing so may require additional coursework above the required number of credits a student needs to graduate.
